



Rabbi Minna Bromberg

Shavuot Artist-in-Residence

Minna Bromberg is a "voicefinder" -- a rabbi, songwriter, and singer who uses the tools of singing and songwriting to help people to bring more of their inherent wholeness to the world. She believes that every voice deserves to be heard and that every one of us has songs that need to be sung. Minna was ordained by the Rabbinical School of Hebrew College in Boston and received her certification as a teacher of Jewish Meditation by Chochmat HaLev in Berkeley. She earned a PhD in sociology from Northwestern University and is an accomplished singer and songwriter. She currently lives in Jerusalem where she teaches voice to emerging leaders and coordinates the Year-in-Israel Program for Hebrew College rabbinical students.
