Dear Parents,

I'm very glad that your child will be joining us at Shorashim this fall. I know you will feel part of the Shorashim community very soon.

Shorashim is a special place that brings many UJC members and their children together every Sunday to share Jewish experiences and study. This coming year we will again offer a full range of activities. Students age 3 to 11 will participate in Judaica and Hebrew classes, while the B'nai Mitzvah Class will help more fully prepare students for this important rite of passage. Additionally, the students' learning will be enriched through holiday celebrations, tzedakah opportunities, and site visits.

This fall **Shorashim will begin on Sunday, 6th September**. We will meet at 9:30 AM in The UJC Sanctuary. The 2020-2021 Shorashim calendar is attached.

We are anticipating that students will return to Shorashim in-person. To ensure everyone's safety, we will coordinate health precautions with The UJC Reopening Working Group, the JCC, and Carmel School. We anticipate that precautions, such as hand washing/sanitizing and mask-wearing will be similar to those observed by students' weekday schools. Exact details will be provided closer to the beginning of Shorashim.

Finally, attached to this letter are the forms necessary to register your child/ren for Shorashim. Please complete the forms and send/email/fax them to The UJC office. Please complete the registration forms as soon as possible, and return them **before 20th August, at the latest**. Returning your forms as early as possible will allow us to better plan and organize for next year. Thank you for your cooperation!

Given the uncertainties of life in Hong Kong at this time, The UJC has maintained 2020-2021 Shorashim tuition at last year's level. If you have *any* financial concerns regarding Shorashim, please speak to me. Your concerns will be held in the strictest confidence.

Because The UJC believes that Jewish education best takes place in the context of a congregational community, Shorashim's tuition structure reflects this fundamental value:

- **UJC members**, pay the base rate tuition.
- Tuition for students whose families are **members in good standing of another Hong Kong congregation (Affiliated)** is double The UJC member level in recognition of that fact that The UJC sponsors most of Shorashim's expenses.
- For **families who choose not to affiliate with any Hong Kong congregation there is a third rate called Unaffiliated**. The UJC, of course, welcomes all Shorashim families to become UJC members.

Books and activities fees are the same for all three tuition levels.

Statement on Shorashim Students' Pictures and Names on The UJC website and In UJC Communications

We are constantly updating congregational and Shorashim information on The UJC website and other communications. In the course of distributing information, it is inevitable that your child/ren's pictures or names may appear on the website or in other communications materials. In an effort to maintain the safety and security of our students we will do the following:

- 1) When a student's picture is published, the student's name will NOT be associated with that picture.
- 2) If student names are published, we will use only the first name of the student. Family/surnames will NOT be published.
- 3) The picture, name, and profile of an upcoming Bar/Bat Mitzvah will be published in Shabbat Shalom at the discretion of the student's parents. (Shabbat Shalom is emailed to the membership but is not viewable or searchable online or on the website without a password. This password will be given out to members upon request.)

PERSONAL INFORMATION COLLECTION STATEMENT

This statement sets out The United Jewish Congregation of Hong Kong Hebrew & Religious School's ("Shorashim") policy and practices in relation to the collection of personal data from a parent and/or guardian (hereinafter collectively referred to as a "Parent") for or in relation to the purposes set out hereunder and the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance (the "Ordinance").

From time to time, it may be necessary for a Parent to supply Shorashim with personal data (which data may relate to the Parent himself/herself or his/her child(ren)) in connection with the attendance of his/her child(ren) at Shorashim.

Failure to supply the requested personal data may result in delay or inability of Shorashim in processing the child(ren)'s registration.

The purposes for which data relating to a Parent and/or his/her child(ren) may be used are as follows:-

- establishing the identity and educational objectives of a Parent
- facilitating the best learning experience possible for the student
- meeting the requirements, including the requirement to make disclosure, under of any law, rules, regulations or codes binding on the Company and/or
- for purposes relating or incidental thereto

Data held by the Shorashim relating to a Parent and/or his/her child(ren) will be kept confidential but the Shorashim may provide, transfer, disclose or exchange such personal data to:-

- any other person under a duty of confidentiality to Shorashim who/which has undertaken to keep such information confidential
- any legal, accounting or professional person, firm or body and
- any government bodies, law enforcement or other regulatory authorities and corporation under any applicable law, rules or regulations

A Parent may be entitled under the Ordinance to request access to or to request the correction of any data supplied by him/her, in the manner and subject to the limitations prescribed therein.

In accordance with the terms of the Ordinance, Shorashim has the right to charge a reasonable fee for the processing of any data access request.
